### **HALL OF FAME – 2005**

**BARBARA FOULK**, member of Madison WBA is inducted into the Madison WBA Hall of Fame in the Meritorious category in August 2005.

Barb has been a member of MWBA for 42 years and during that time served on the MWBA Board of Directors for 17 years, 9 of which were in the position of Treasurer.

During these years, Barb has served on many committees including Budget and Finance for 11 years, Legislative, MWBA Tournament Bid, and Awards. In 1993-1995, she served on the WWBA Tournament Bid Committee and held the position of State Tournament House Chairman in 1983 and tournament worker in 1997.

Barb was a member of the Madison Bowling Council for 5 years and for several years she served on the Madison 600 Club as its President.

As a delegate, Barb has represented MWBA at 4 WIBC Annual Meetings and for 4 years at the WWBA Annual Meeting. As a participant, Barb has bowled in both national and state championship tournaments.

On the local level, Barb attended many MWBA annual membership meetings and not only participated in over 20 MWBA Championship Tournaments, but was an active tournament worker as well.

During her bowling career, Barb credits a 256 as her high game, a high series of 710 and has a career high average of over 180.

Barb has served the association well with her interest in the sport, by her dedication and by her participation in many aspects of the game of bowling.
