

MADISON USBC WOMEN'S BOWLING ASSOCIATION HALL OF FAME

Darlene Duckert is inducted into the MWBA Hall of Fame in the Superior Performance category in August 2009.

Darlene was introduced to bowling at Waterloo's Hildebrandt Lanes in 1968, the start of a great bowling career. She moved to Madison, and in 1971 she joined the MWBA where she has remained an active member for 38 years. Darlene's career has spanned many of the Madison area's bowling centers, including Casino/All Star Lanes, Burr Oaks Bowl, Dream Lanes, Prairie Lanes and she is currently bowling at Bowl-a-Vard and Village Lanes.

Darlene has been a contributing member of 5 MWBA Division 1 championship teams, competing in both 4- and 5-person team events. In 1998, teamed with Jill Doucette, Darlene posted a 600 series to take the MWBA's Division 1 Doubles Title – they posted a score of 1225.

With a high series of 703, high game of 279 and carrying an average of 180 or better for 14 years, Darlene has helped propel her teams to 9 Association season-high team series and 6 Association season-high team games. In 2006 Darlene posted her highest league average of 192. Her most outstanding and "consistent" performance in bowling is a 702 series with games of 234, 235 and 233.

Over the years, Darlene has served as a team captain and secretary in her various leagues. She has participated in 32 Wisconsin Women's State Championship Tournaments. Darlene is a member of the national, state and local 600 clubs.

Darlene loves bowling, is a great competitor, and whether you are bowling with her or against her, you can be assured it will be a great time on the lanes!
