HALL OF FAME – 2003

MARCY KLEINSTEIBER, is inducted posthumously into the Madison WBA Hall of Fame in the Superior Performance category in August 2003.

Marcy was a member of MWBA for 41 years, carried a lifetime average of 170 but maintained a 185 average during 1971-72.

During her years as an MWBA bowler, Marcy competed in 41 MWBA Championship Tournaments and from 1954 to 1976 finished as first place champion 14 times in various events. In addition, she garnered 19 second or third place finishes.

On the state level, she bowled in 28 WWBA Championship Tournaments and in 1970 Marcy teamed up with Dee Fix to win WWBA Doubles Championship with 1212 scratch.

Marcy bowled on the Kupfer Iron Works Team for several years and served as it's captain for many of those years. She was also a strong force as a member of the Bowl-A-Vard Team as a member of Rhodes Steak House Team.

She served on the MWBA Board of Directors for 4 years both as a Director and as 1st Vice President. She was a member of the national, state, and local 600 Clubs. For many years, Marcy assisted with the junior bowling program at Burr Oaks Bowl and at Bowl-A-Vard Lanes.

Marcy was a strong competitor and an inspiration to others to attain success on the lanes.
