

MADISON USBC WOMEN'S BOWLING ASSOCIATION HALL OF FAME

Sherrí Stampfli is inducted into the MWBA Hall of Fame in the Superior Performance category in August 2008.

Sherrí has been bowling for 32 years and has been a member of the MWBA for 21 years. She started her bowling career in 1975 in the Bantam league at Middleton Sport Bowl at the young age of seven. She progressed through the Junior program and joined the MWBA in 1987.

Ten years later Sherrí and her Middleton Sport Bowl team took home the 4-person high scratch series and game titles posting 2255 and 810 respectively. She also had the tournament high scratch game of 290. The following year her Stan's Girls 3-person team posted the high scratch score of 1716 and she once again posted the high scratch game of the tournament with 277. In 2000 she helped her Zelda and Crew Team to the 4-person scratch title with a 2171 and that same year she teamed up with Marge Pursell to take the Division 1 Doubles scratch title with 1179. The following three years Sherrí joined the Pursell's Proshop team to win division scratch titles.

Sherrí not only participates in our local championship tournament but also our local Queen's tournament, the WWBA championship tournament and the national tournament.

In 1988 Sherrí became a member of the 600 club and in 1996 joined the National 700 club when she posted a career high 739 series. She went on to post 5 more 700 series. Sherrí's highest sanctioned game came in 1996 when she bowled a 299 in the Rowdy Rollers League at Middleton Sport Bowl. She holds a career high average of 200.

Sherrí is not only a bowler but also a promoter and organizer. In 1995 Sherrí formed the Sport Bowl Mixers league and immediately became league secretary and treasurer. In 1997 she organized the Tuesday Night Lions League and continues to serve as its secretary and treasurer. Sherrí has worked to promote bowling as a competitive sport but she also enjoys organizing groups to take part in 8- and 9-pin tap tourneys and Scottish-doubles events throughout WI.

Sherrí is enthusiastic about all aspects of bowling - a real credit to our sport!
